This workshop will give you an introduction to some of the tools necessary for effective debriefing in your own environment. A considerable amount of time and expertise has been dedicated to making this workshop the best it can be. Because video assisted metadebriefing is a central activity for the SCSC as part of our faculty development programme, we have been able to identify what works and what doesn't work in debriefing in a variety of situations. You will also have an opportunity to share and discuss particular challenges you may have already faced running simulation based medical education.
